1. Introduction

Procedures for compliments are as follows:

1.2 All parents are given the opportunity to complete an annual Parent Questionnaire. We invite parents to give comments regarding all aspects of school life. These are shared with the school's governing body and a response is shared with all parents.

- 1.3 Ofsted invite parents to comment on the school on their website. Parents can visit www.parentview.ofsted.gov.uk and to share their thoughts about our school.
- 1.4 We encourage parents to talk to class teachers and the Head Teacher, both formally and informally and your compliments and comments can be passed on at drop-off and collection times. Additionally, parents may wish to comment during Parent/ Teacher conferences.
